Dr Sally Payne, Trustee and Professional Advisor at the Royal College of Occupational Therapists shares an overview of the results of a national survey around adult diagnosis.

Dr Emma Tremaine (The Dyspraxic Doctor) talking about Dyspraxia: Anxiety, mental health and wellbeing.

Kerry Pace of Diverse Learners and recent Rising Star Award winner for her work in education and supporting learners with disabilities talks about supporting students with the opportunity to ask questions.

Laurence Turner; Research and Policy Officer at GMB Trade Union talks about the Guide to Dyspraxia in the Workplace as part of the GMB *Thinking Differently at Work* campaign.

Listen to lived experiences from adults with dyspraxia talking about growing up, living and working with the condition, network and ask questions. Closing speaker to be confirmed.
